Forwarding Letter

Greetings from MEGST in the most precious name of our Lord Jesus, the Christ!

With joy and gratitude, I would like to share an update on what the Lord has been doing within the MEGST community amid the country's challenges. God enabled us to celebrate His goodness during the past academic year. Our 2024-2025 academic year concluded on 15 February 2025 with great success, marking the graduation of 32 MDiv students and 7 Doctor of Ministry students. We are proud of our team, which works tirelessly to ensure the success of our programmes. We also thank our dedicated students for their hard work and celebrate their well-earned degrees.

Our year-end programmes, the Mission Emphasis week, the Graduation Banquet, and the Graduation Service went exceptionally well. Over 400 people attended our grand banquet, and approximately 900 were present at our graduation ceremony. Our esteemed overseas guests and speakers significantly enriched our events: Dr. Riad Kasis, the International Director of Langham Partnerships, Lebanon; Brother Russell Thorp, Executive Director of Beacon Partnerships, New Zealand; and Sister Gillean Smiley, Chief Executive Officer of Langham Partnerships, Australia. Words cannot adequately express our gratitude for their presence and support of our ministry in Myanmar.

Once again, divine providence has demonstrated its favour upon our ministry. We are pleased to inform you that approximately 60 new students have enrolled for the 2025-2026 academic year, resulting in a total of 109 full-time students in our MDiv and MTh programs. Our part-time programmes have over 100 students, including 49 in the Doctor of Ministry, 23 in the MA in Leadership, and 17 in the Graduate Diploma. Twelve students are starting our MA Youth programme. Crossing the 200-student mark is a historic milestone for MEGST, despite ongoing uncertainties in Myanmar. Please pray for the health and well-being of our faculty and staff as they serve our students effectively. We plan to recruit new members to strengthen our team and sustain the growth in the coming years.

On 28 March 2025, a powerful earthquake with a magnitude of 7.7 struck Myanmar, further intensifying the country's ongoing issues of political instability, economic hardship, and soaring inflation. Fortunately, with support from MEGST's friends both locally and internationally, the MEGST team was able to participate in humanitarian efforts to aid the regions affected by the earthquake, especially Mandalay and Sagaing. This marks an excellent new step for our community in connecting with people around us, regardless of their religious background.

Let us believe that God will meet our needs and perform even greater miracles through MEGST in the years to come. Stay faithful, trusting in His goodness and care. May God's blessings be with you all.


>>> Bible Donation

>>> DR CHRIS STEED






